A Message from Campaign President SUSAN GILL

It is hard to believe 2013 will soon come to a close and this will mark our third year since the founding of our non-profit and the start of our Campaign. Beginning with discovery, research and planning the preparation for the retrofit construction of the Mission is well underway.

Mission San Antonio de Padua has invested \$512,711.00 of the more than \$1.5 million dollars raised thus far. Studies conducted and completed include seismic, hydrology, land surveys, flood report and archeology. Pre-construction work also included hazardous removal of materials and the replacement of the leach field on the west side of the Mission. In addition, the welcome removal of the old boiler and heating system in the Church and its replacement with a new system has been "warmly" received. The front bathrooms are currently being upgraded and will be finished in the new year. Mechanical and engineering plans also comprise elements of our campaign's investment to date.

The board is pleased that we have begun the necessary work to engage in the critical path that will allow the major phases of construction to occur as we strive to meet the challenge of funding the project. At our most recent board meeting Brian Kelly, facilitator and liaison for the Diocese on the retrofit of The Royal Presidio Chapel (San Carlos Cathedral), Monterey, and The Carmel Mission provided an in depth presentation of those experiences. The amount of daily decision making involved was an eye opener for the board. Matching materials that were used in original construction, historic significance issues, discoveries and how to adjust and preserve are among the many issues dealt with daily. The Campaign to Preserve Mission San Antonio de Padua appreciates and will benefit from Brian Kelly's experience.

To expand our fundraising options, this year the board approved a policy to allow the ability to accept property and stocks and we generously received our first donation of property. Many have asked about donor recognition and we are pleased to announce a donor monument will be built in the Mission Courtyard to recognize donors at various levels.

We have a big challenge ahead of us to raise enough money to be able to begin the roof repair next year. We know that many letters are sent this time of the year asking for support. We hope that you will help us with this most immediate need and choose to include the Campaign in your end of the year giving plans.
