Ringling in the News of the Preservation Campaign for Mission San Antonio de Padua

A Message from Campaign Co-Presidents SUSAN GILL & ANN BECKETT

As we start 2021, the Phase V work at Mission San Antonio is coming to an end and it looks like it will be complete by the end of this year. As we reflect on these past 10+ years many thoughts come to mind. We have a sincere sense of gratitude for all who have been a part of this long journey along with feelings of joy and pride to be one of the only California Missions to complete all the seismic work needed throughout their entire mission complex.

The Campaign for the Preservation of Mission San Antonio de Padua Foundation was formed in 2010 to fund the seismic retrofit repair and the preservation of the structural integrity of the historic and beloved Mission. The Foundation's intent when formed was to raise funds to ensure that this landmark, an important piece of California's history, is

saved, so that visitors and the greater community can experience this historical treasure and its inspiring serenity for years to come. At the time the estimate to complete all five phases was \$12-15 million. Looking at what is left to complete this year we anticipate we will be well within original project estimates, finishing at approximately \$12.1-\$12.2 million.

When we sent one of our first newsletters in 2012 the opening message read: *Faith, hard work and a persevering spirit committed to illuminating Mission San Antonio's enriching story to an increasingly larger community are absolute requirements for our*

ultimate project success. It will take time, money and the continual investment of responsible people with vision to raise the funds.

It remains a monumental task – a task that offers numerous opportunities for individuals and groups to become a critical part of something bigger than themselves. It is a mission that allows people to put their fingerprints onto a jewel from the past while preserving it and passing it on to the generations of the future.



The faith, hard work and perseverance of our committed Board of Directors has made this project a success and we have been extremely fortunate to have the support of countless long standing donors, many who have generously given numerous times throughout our multi-year campaign. It was indeed a monumental task and we were reminded of this at

various times over this last decade, and yet we all continued through the ups and downs and together are nearing the end of an amazing accomplishment. The work which has been completed would not have been possible without your dedication of time, energy and financial support. You have all put your fingerprints onto this jewel and timeless treasure, ensuring it will remain for future generations, and we sincerely thank you. We look forward to when the restrictions from the pandemic ease and we can all celebrate together at Mission San Antonio. ■

A New World—*A Mission San Antonio de Padua Update*

MARCH, 2021 – we are living in a new world. For the past year we have faced crises in health, safety, justice, equality and economics. We've been tested repeatedly and we've risen to meet the challenges. Life has continued on and our mission to retrofit and restore Mission San Antonio has continued to move steadily forward.

We are now one year past the date (March 18, 2019) when the Mission was closed to the public due to the COVID-19 pandemic. While we have suffered hardship due to loss of income, the Mission's restoration work has flourished. As essential workers, the construction teams have been allowed to continue the restoration work that your generous donations have made possible.

Many members of the community have given financial support to this worthy historic endeavor. We call it our *hundred-year-fix*, but, in essence, done well, this project's rewards will continue well beyond the next one hundred years.

Focus now is shifting from the seismic stabilization of the buildings to the preservation and interpretation of the artifacts and the historic site. New signage is being installed to replace deteriorating signs, with accompanying tour guide brochures being designed and printed.

Interpretive diagrams and murals are planned additions for the

museum walls. New cases that will better display and better preserve our artifacts are needed. Work in these areas is scheduled to begin soon. Our Retreat Center common areas – Conference Room, Ecumenical Chapel and Dining Rooms – are currently being upgraded to enhance the retreat experience for our guests.

Visitors will enjoy the improved trails to historical locations on site and will be especially appreciative of the rebirth of the quadrangle garden, now flourishing with native plants, wild California poppies, a restored fountain and winding walkways. The sounds of cascading water and birds singing enhance the calming spirit of the Mission. Eroding adobe foundational ruins must be preserved by the addition of a sacrificial layer of limewash, which also serves to better delineate their historical locations within the 86-acre Mission property.

The archives storage area still needs a lot of work. Enhanced storage cabinets to provide fire/moisture and insect/rodent protection are needed. Artifact catalogs need to be converted into more accessible formats and all materials need to be stored in optimal conditions.

Yes, we are now living in a new world but we have used this past year, when we've been closed to the public, to accomplish a great deal of our restoration work. We remain closed to the public at this



time but are hoping and working towards the day when we can once again open the main gates to visitors and guests. We will continue to responsibly utilize the funds you have so generously donated to this worthy project to get the job done. We look forward to the



day when each of you can come see, in person, all that you have helped make possible. We will be ready with a newly restored, newly reinforced, newly reborn Mission ... ready to meet the needs of our new world. ■

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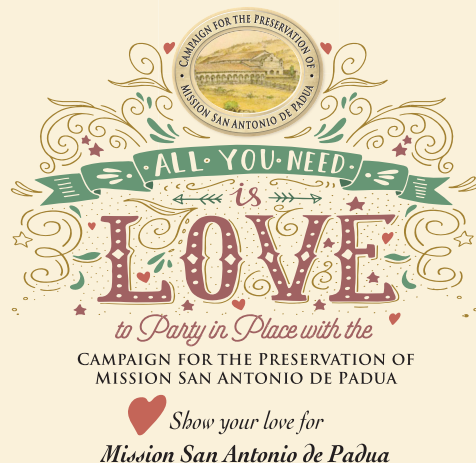
